**Phase 1 Remote Learning:** Just a reminder that the district chose to return to Phase 1 – remote learning everyday starting Monday, November 23 through at least Winter Break. There will be communication in the next few weeks for the plan starting in January. Please look for communication from your child's teacher with the daily schedule and tips for a successful transition back to Phase 1. (Early Childhood parents...please see communication from the Early Childhood department so you know what that means for your child).

Just a reminder that our school day will still be 7:45 am - 2:20 pm each day. Teachers will provide a balance of synchronous, asynchronous, and independent activities. Students will not be on the computer all day, but we will be accessing them at different times throughout the day based on need, groups, activity, and grade level. Look for specifics from your child's teacher.

Attendance practices will remain the same: Students will log on at 7:45 am and teachers will take attendance by 8:00 am each day. Starting at 8:30 am, Mrs. Miller will make attendance phone calls home for any student that was not marked absent and that we had not heard from on the attendance line. Please continue to call the attendance line if your student will not be participating in class that day. Be sure to indicate the reason for their absence. Thank you!

**Lunch provided at McGraw:** McGraw Elementary has been identified as a community location to receive lunch. ALL students are eligible to receive a free lunch. Lunch will be set up outside in the front of McGraw, everyday from 11:00-1:00. It will be curbside pick-up so staff will hand the pre-packaged lunch to families inside their car. Just pull up curbside between 11:00 and 1:00 and we will hand you the number of lunches you need.

**Laptop HELP!!!** Please help your child understand the importance of protecting their laptop and all electronic devices. McGraw and the district are getting critically low due to the number of laptops that are damaged. Please continue to reach out if something is not working and we will troubleshoot solutions. Many of the issues we see are because it was dropped, students are eating around it and food gets in the keyboard and makes it unusable, liquids are getting spilled, etc. At school, we do very specific teach to's about how to safely carry and use their laptop which includes using two hands when transporting, do not carry it from the screen side, no food/drink etc. anywhere near their workspace. Thank you for your help!
